






### Key knowledge - Notation

- The treble clef notes for the pentatonic scale
- Notes are grouped into beats
- Japanese music uses specific instruments and notes

### Key Knowledge - Listening

- Composers change tempo for specific effect
- The orchestra has 4 sections of instruments (brass, woodwind, strings, percussion)
- Instruments in each orchestral section make their sound in a similar way
- Music is composed for a specific purpose
- Classical composer

<b>shamisen</b>	a traditional Japanese three-stringed lute, with a square body, played with a plectrum		<b>shakuhachi</b>	a Japanese vertical, bamboo flute	
<b>Japan</b>	an archipelago of over 6000 islands		<b>classical music</b>	music which is mostly played by the orchestra
