Reception Baseline Assessment

Dear Parents and Carers,

As your child begins their Reception year, we would like to let you know about the **Reception Baseline Assessment (RBA)**. This is a short, national assessment that all children in Reception take part in.

The assessment:

- takes about 20 minutes in total (sometimes done in two 10-minute sessions),
- is carried out in a calm, supportive environment with your child's teacher,
- looks at early language, communication, literacy and maths skills,
- is designed to be practical and interactive, not a "test" in the traditional sense.

The information gathered will be used by the Government to measure children's progress from Reception through to the end of Year 6. It will not be used to judge individual children, and you will not receive a score or result.
