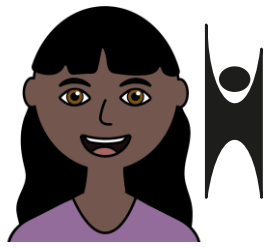


What questions does the story of creation make us ask?

Different people have different answers to these tricky questions.



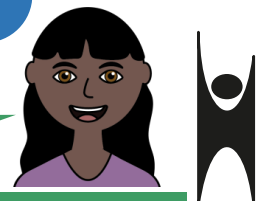
Danny
